Guidelines on Medical Examination and Disease Control of Students

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1. In order to know the physical conditions of students, find signs or symptoms of disease from them at an early stage, improve their health, protect health of KMU teachers, staff and students, undergo control and prevention of infectious disease in the campus, and maintain public health and safety, the Guidelines are drawn out in accordance with Article 8 and Article 10 of School Health Act.
2. New students are required to undergo medical examination upon enrollment. New undergraduates should submit medical examination certificates issued by the affiliated hospital of KMU. New students of Two-Year In-Service Program and Graduate Institutes (Master Program, Doctoral Program) may submit medical examination certificates issued by district hospitals. If necessary, all or part of the students shall be temporarily asked to undergo medical examination.
3. New students failing to complete medical examination and submit medication examination certificate within the specified period shall have their registration regarded as not completed yet, and Student ID Card shall not be issued to them.
4. Division of Health Service shall register and make statistics of the medical examination results of students, trace the students with symptoms of disease, offer health care advice to them and inform the related units.
5. Should signs or symptoms of disease be found from students in medical examination, Division of Health Service shall be responsible for contacting with the person concerned, and urge him/her to seek treatment and track health condition.
6. Should a student be found getting open infectious disease, the Division of Health Service shall report the case to the related unit and discuss about the measures to be taken.
7. The students of KMU should abide by and cooperate with the measures of Prevention and Control Strategies and Plan of Infectious Disease formulated by the competent authorities of the Central Government, including vaccination, infectious disease prevention, epidemic surveillance, reporting, investigation, inspection, handling and training.
8. The overseas Chinese and foreign students coming from epidemic areas should go to the unit designated by the competent authorities of health affairs to take disease and blood tests, which shall be under control and tracked by the Division of Health Service of KMU.
9. Having been examined and approved at the administrative meeting, and submitted to the President and achieving the President's approval, the Guidelines are implemented from the date of announcement. Any amendments to the Guidelines shall also be processed in the same way.
