


Taisvan – University of Sydney Pasteraduale Research Scholarship

Supporting Taxwanese students undertaking PhD studies at the University of Sydney



Scholarship details

The scholarship covers the costs of the annual University of Sydney tuition fee for the successful applicant's PhD program (international students rate); and an annual stipend/living allowance, which will be at the same rate as that for RTP International scholarships (\$37,207 AUD in 2023).

Background

This scholarship is co-funded by The Department of International and Cross-Strait Education (DICE) of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of China (Taiwan) and the University of Sydney. Up to five PhD scholarships will be available each year.

Who's eligible

Students must:

- be a citizen of Taiwan (ROC)
- be a prospective student (not yet commenced at the University)
- have applied for admission in a PhD at the University by 30 November 2023.

The scholarship is available in **ALL** study areas.
