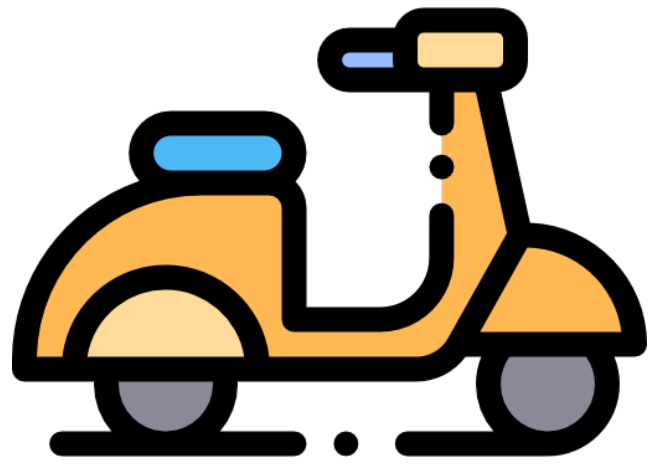




Brief Guide GETTING A MOTORCYCLE LICENSE IN TAIWAN

1 Initiation/ Health Examination

visit your local Motor Vehicle Office with

- A **Driver's License Application Form**
- A valid **physical health exam** from an official physical examination center in the past year
- **Alien Residence Certificate** (ARC)
- **Passport**
- 3 one-inch passport **photos** (taken within the past 2 years)



2 Written Test

- The test consists of **50 questions** (30 multiple-choice and 20 true/false).
- The passing score is **85%**.
- You can find **practice apps and resources online** to prepare.
- **English-language** test are available (exams require appointments in advance and are not available at all MVO locations).

Road Test 3

- Pass a practical driving test on a closed course.
- Evaluate your ability to ride **straight, turn, and follow traffic signals**.
- Prepare your own motorcycle and helmet.

4 Get the License

Once you pass both tests, you can apply for your license.



Additional Remarks

- For the **first 30 days**, you can drive on an International Driving Permit from your home country (only applicable for nationals from **reciprocal countries**). See [the table for Driving License with Our Reciprocal Countries](#).
- To use an International Driving Permit for **up to 1 year**, you must register it by visiting the Motor Vehicle Office. Bring your **ARC** and **passport**. Fees apply: [OFFICIAL LINK](#).
- Usually, **beyond one year** you must obtain a local Taiwanese drivers license, either by taking the driver's license exam or converting your foreign license. It depends on reciprocity terms, duration of stay, and validity of the international driver's license.
