



Getting a SIM Card and Internet Plan



How to Get a SIM Card



- Go to a mobile store or convenience store
- Bring your passport and student ID
- Choose prepaid (pay as you go) or monthly plan
- Insert the SIM card and activate it



Tips for purchasing

- **Airport:**
At the airport, your passport is usually sufficient
- **City Stores:**
Some stores may require a second form of ID, like a ARC, student ID (for student plan) in addition to your passport
- **Major Providers:**
All major providers (Chunghwa Telecom, Taiwan Mobile, and FarEasTone) offer excellent coverage throughout Taiwan

Where to buy

- **Airport Kiosks:** Taipei Taoyuan International Airport has kiosks in both arrival and departure halls for major providers
- **Carrier Stores:** Official stores of Chunghwa Telecom, Taiwan Mobile, and FarEasTone offer a wider selection and assistance

Reminders



- Prepaid is good if you're unsure how much data you need
- Check for student discounts
- Don't click on unknown links or pop-ups—avoid scams!
- Get advises from your seniors
