Brief Step for obtaining drivers license in Taiwan

1. Health Examination:

2. Written Test:

- You must pass a written test on traffic regulations.
- The test consists of 50 questions (30 multiple-choice and 20 true/false).
- The passing score is 85%.
- You can find practice apps and resources online to prepare.
- English-language test are available

3. Road Test:

- You must pass a practical driving test on a closed course.
- The test assesses your ability to perform various maneuvers, such as riding on a narrow straight line, making turns, and following traffic signals.
- You must provide your own motorcycle and helmet for the test.

4. The License:

Once you pass both tests, you can apply for your license.

Introduction

Driving in Taiwan

 For the first 30 days, you can drive on an International Driving Permit from your home country. To check further extend it please go to link:

Most common drivers license exam in Taiwan are,

- 1. Motorcycles 49cc and under (Light)
- 2. Motorcycles 50cc to 249cc (Normal)
- 3. Motorcycles 250cc and above (Heavy)
- 4. Ordinary Light Vehicle (Automatic Transmission)
- 5. Ordinary Light Vehicle (Manual Transmission)

Introduction

- **50cc or less:** White text on a green background. This category is for "light-duty motorcycles".
- **50cc to 250cc:** Black text on a white background. These are considered "ordinary heavy-duty motorcycles" and are the most common.
- **250cc to 550cc:** Black text on a yellow background. This is the first class of "large heavy-duty motorcycle".
- 550cc and above: White text on a red background. This is the
 highest classification of "large heavy-duty motorcycle." These are
 treated similarly to cars in some traffic laws, and in some cases,
 have access to certain roads that yellow-plate motorcycles do not.

Reminders for driver license test appointments:


- 1. If you are unable to take the test on the day of the test, please cancel your appointment online no later than 7:00 am on the day of the test, or call to cancel during the service hours of the appointment station on the same day. If you fail to show up for three appointments within two months, your license will be suspended for two months (the suspension period starts from the date of the last appointment).
- 2. Starting from January 2016, driver license test appointments will be fully open.
- 3. All license tests will be booked online, and on-site registration will not be accepted.
- 4. On the day of the test, please prepare the **original ID card and three 1-inch photos**, complete the **physical examination**, and complete the registration process according to the deadline of each license inspection station . **First-time (motorcycle) driver's license candidates must participate in a 120-minute safety lecture before the written test and road test .** For detailed test information, please visit the homepage of each appointment inspection station.
- 5. If there is a natural disaster (such as a typhoon) on the day of the test and the service is suspended, all appointments for that day will be cancelled. Candidates are requested to re-schedule and register on their own.
- 6. The motorcycle license exam at the Lianjiang Motorcycle Inspection Station is scheduled for Monday at noon. (First-time applicants must complete a safety briefing and check in before 12:30 AM. Those who do not require a briefing (those retaking a suspended license or those holding a light motorcycle license) check in between 1:30 PM and 2:00 PM. Please bring your medical form and relevant documents to the station during the registration period.)

2.1. Written test


- The written test for motorcycles lasts 30 minutes and consists of 50 questions, 30 multiple choice, 20 true-false. 85% is passing.
- The written test for vehicles lasts 30 minutes and consists of 25 questions on provisions and 15 questions on road signs. 85% is passing.



Making appointment for written test

Documents for Drivers license application:

- 1. A Driver's License Application Form
- 2. A valid **physical health exam** from an official physical examination center (valid for a year)
- 3. Alien Residence Certificate (ARC) or Gold Card with validity of over six months
- 4. Passport
- 5. Three one-inch passport photos (taken within the past 2 years)

Steps for getting a license in Taiwan

- 1. Complete Motorcycle hazard perception exam (simulation/online exam).
- 2. Make an appointment for written exam and practical exam.
- 3. Get your license.
