Muslim community in Kaohsiung Taiwan

About 4,000 to 5,000 Muslims live in Kaohsiung now, and most of them are Indonesian. Others come from Pakistan, India, Turkey and Malaysia. Every Friday, they give prayers at Kaohsiung Muslim Mosque at noon.

Kaohsiung Muslim Mosque is the second mosque built by the early believers in Taiwan, and today it's still among the six largest mosques in the country. It's one of the only two places for Muslims to give prayers in southern Taiwan. Its services extend to Hualien of the East Coast.

Every summer, the mosque organizes classes for learning Islamic culture and the Arabic language, especially for youngsters to learn the teachings of Islam.

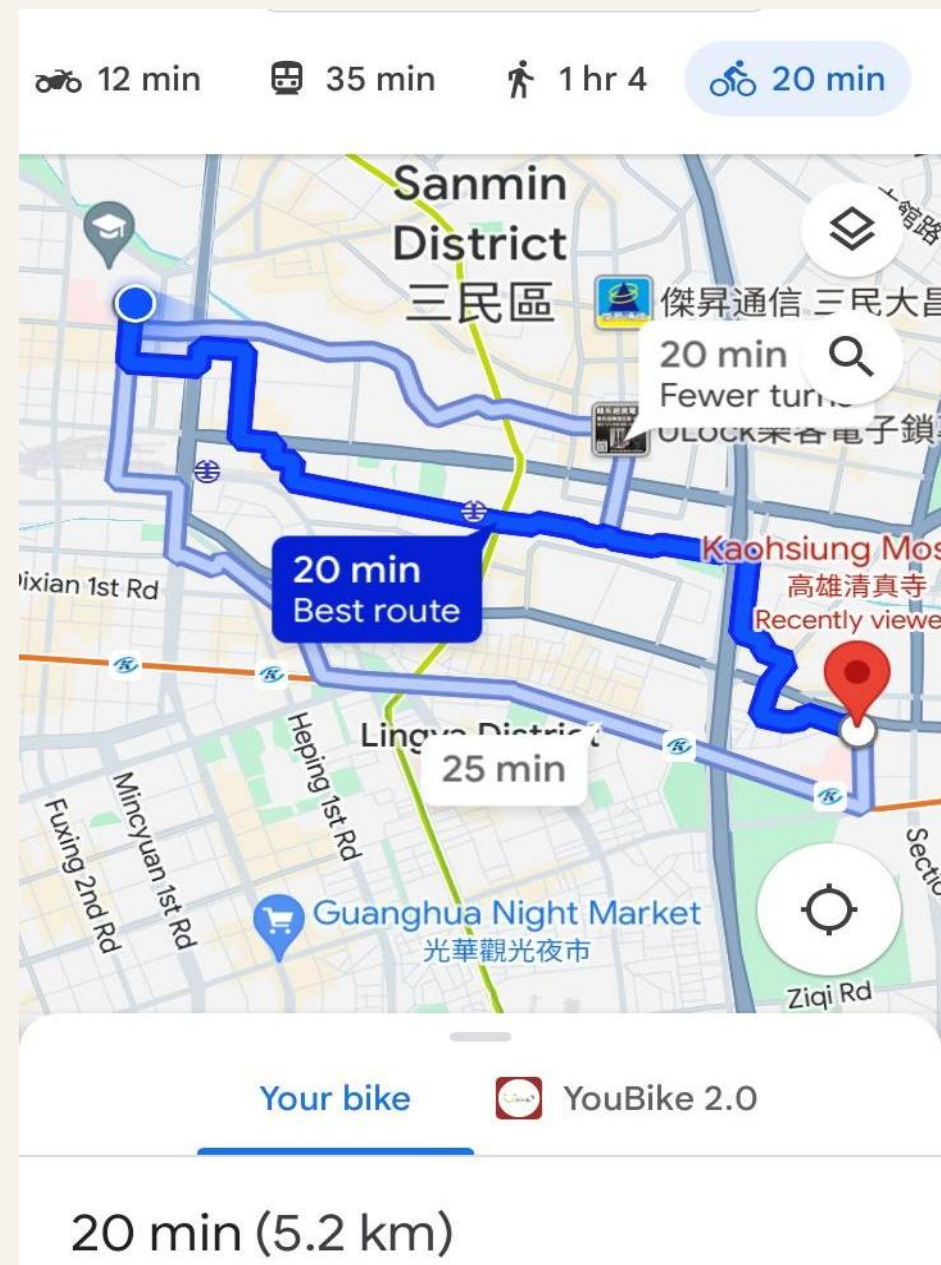

History: The Kaohsiung Mosque (Chinese: 高雄清真寺) is a mosque in [Lingya District, Kaohsiung](#), Taiwan. It is the second mosque to be built in Taiwan after Taipei Grand Mosque in Taipei. Kaohsiung Mosque was built in 1949 in Taiwan.

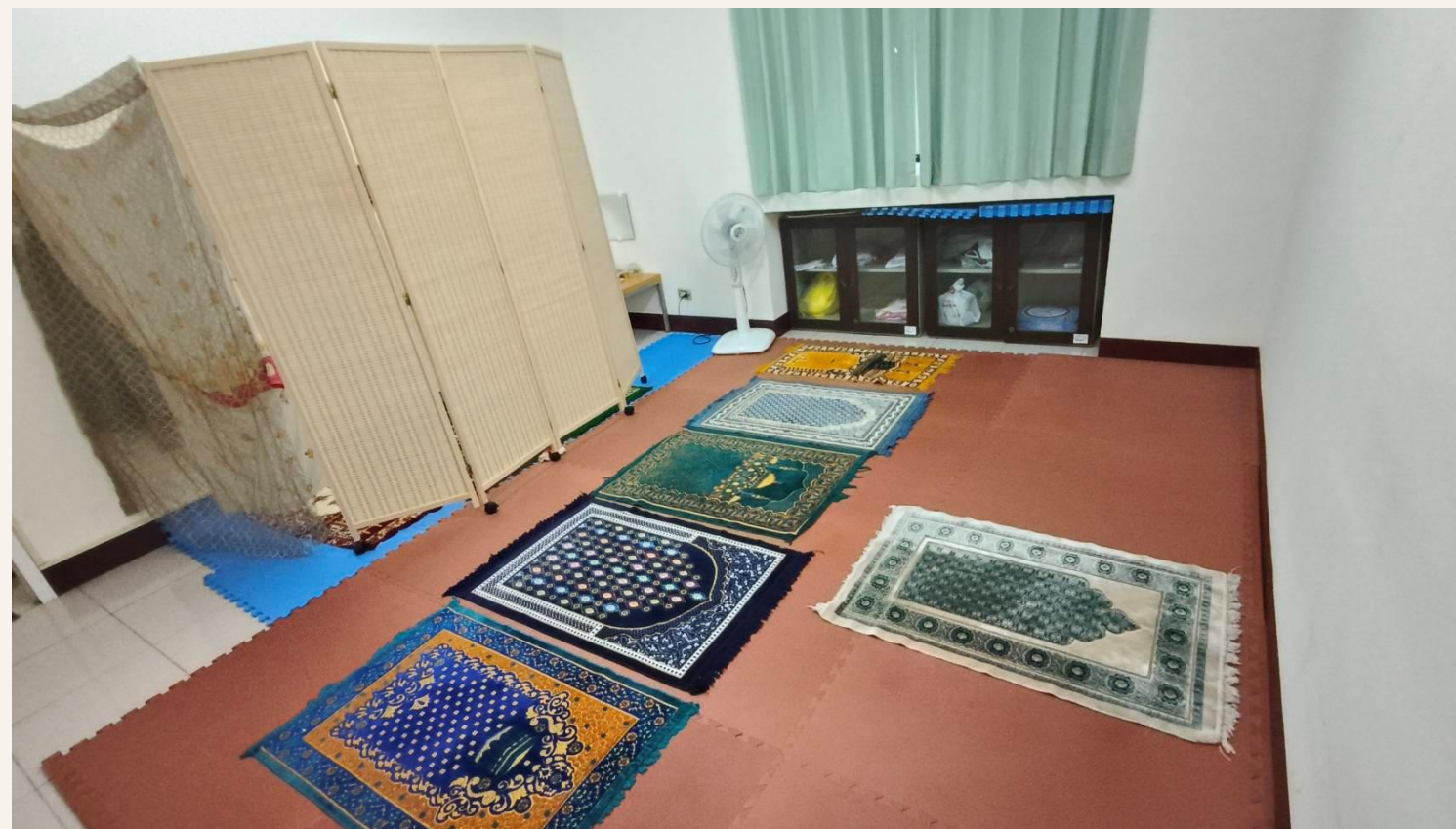

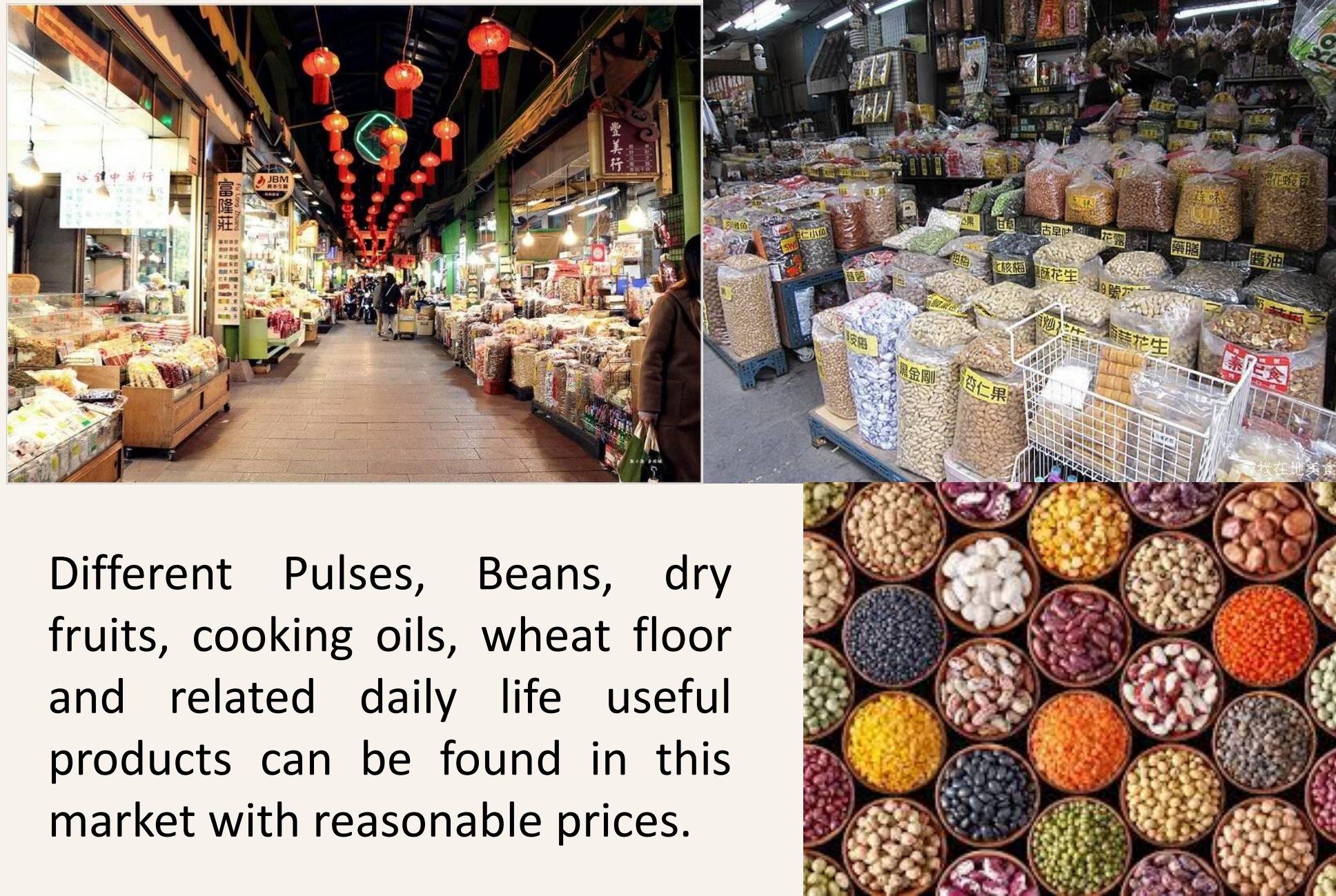

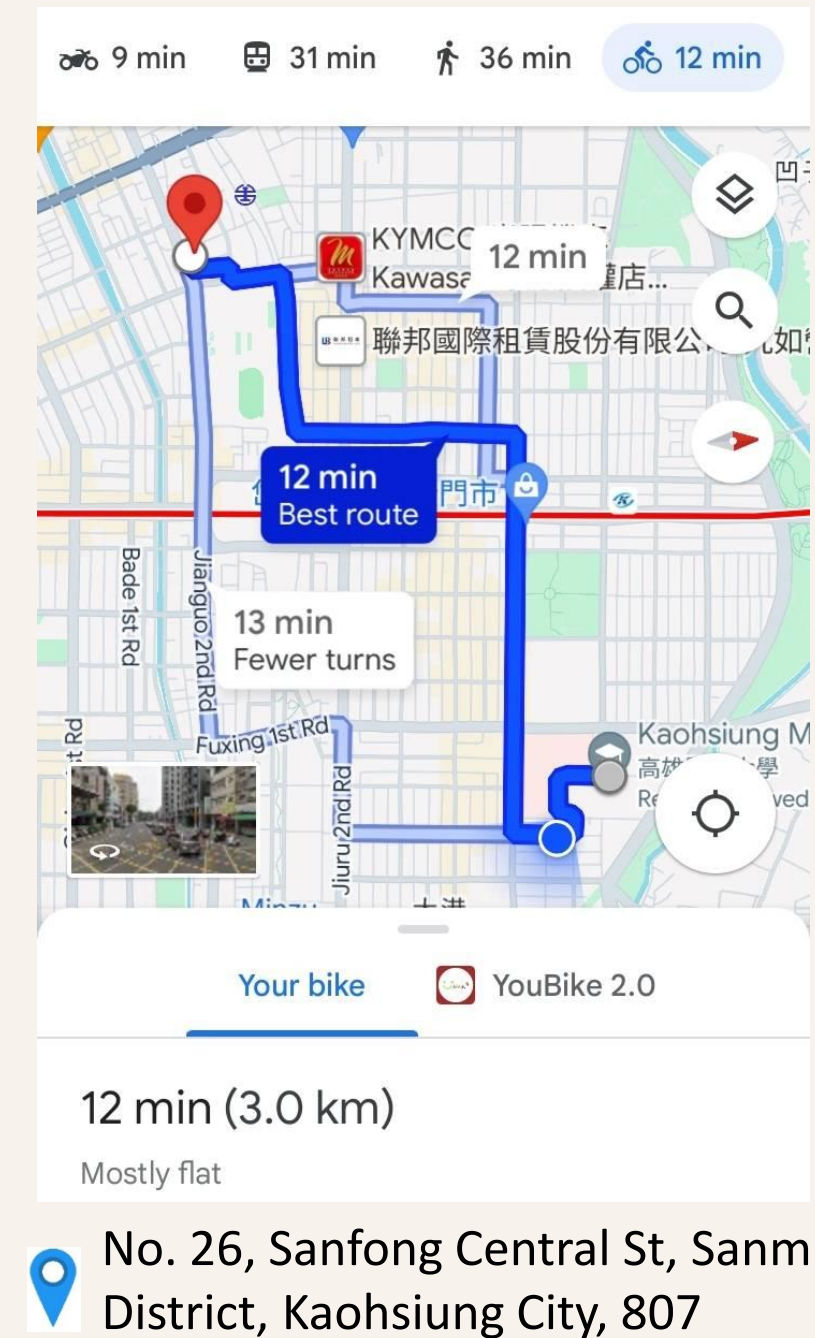

Different Pulses, Beans, dry fruits, cooking oils, wheat flour and related daily life useful products can be found in this market with reasonable prices.

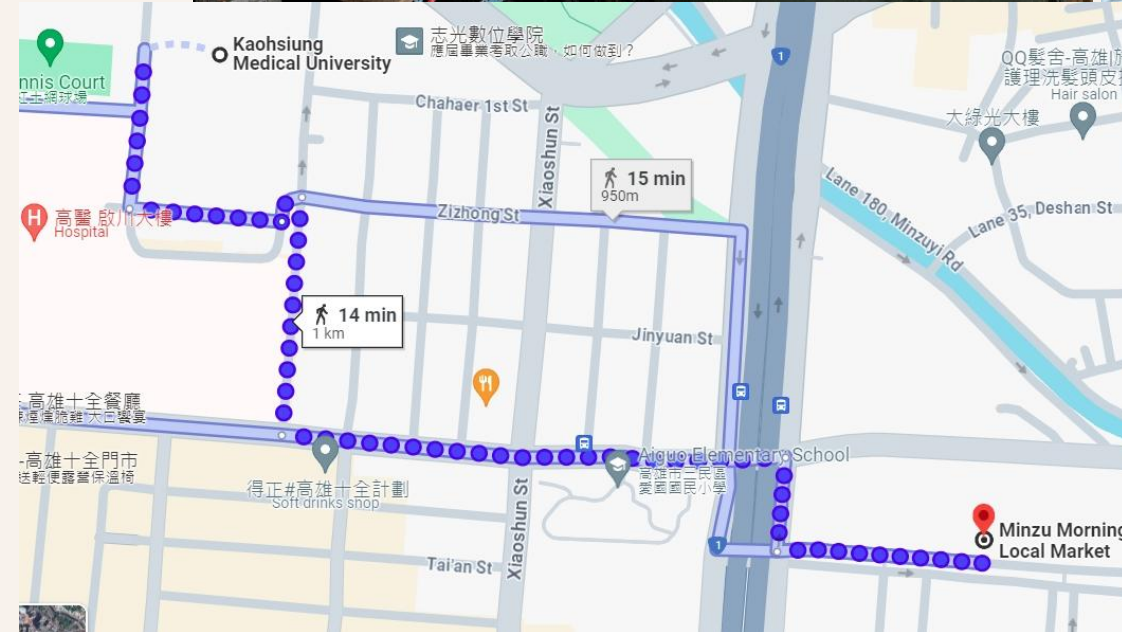

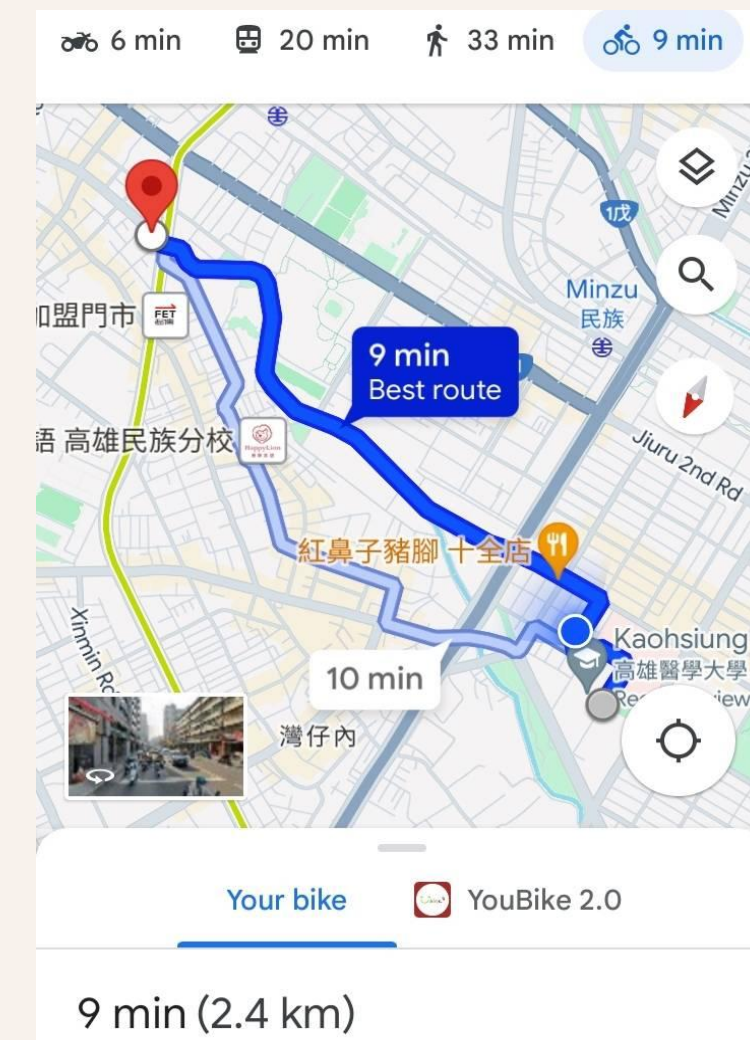

Food- Restaurants Precautions

Halal food places and options available to Muslim in Kaohsiung city:

My friends, we know very well that every country has its own food customs and culture that are unique from others, and we know that just because food is different does not mean that all of it is inappropriate or not halal for us as Muslims.

So, you should just ask firstly about that your previous Muslim students here in Taiwan or be clear in asking the locals when buying food to make sure it is free of both alcohol and pork.

All restaurants here do not serve meat that is halal or slaughtered in the Islamic manner. You will find some restaurants that state that they are halal, but in reality, they only mean that their meat is not pork.

The rest of the foods in Taiwan are vegetarian, Vegan, fish, dairy products, etc., which are without any additives and are suitable for Muslims. But remember to use Google translator to translate the ingredients, and you can also ask kindly to verify that they are free of additives such as alcohol or pork fat derivatives.

Note: The rules of these restaurants may have been revised recently, so you must ensure that the food served is still halal according to Islamic law.
